

The action of the play, which is virtually continuous, takes place in the Malayan jungle during the Japanese advance on Singapore early in 1942. It is afternoon and the Japanese are being held by British forces twenty miles to the north.

At this time, the British Far East Command was centred on Singapore, an apparently impregnable fortress, four hundred miles to the south. The Malay Peninsula was occupied by British forces, many of them inexperienced and unused to jungle warfare.

N.B. No character in this play is intended to portray any specific person, alive or dead.

There will be one interval of fifteen minutes.

GALE SHAW "PRODUCER"


