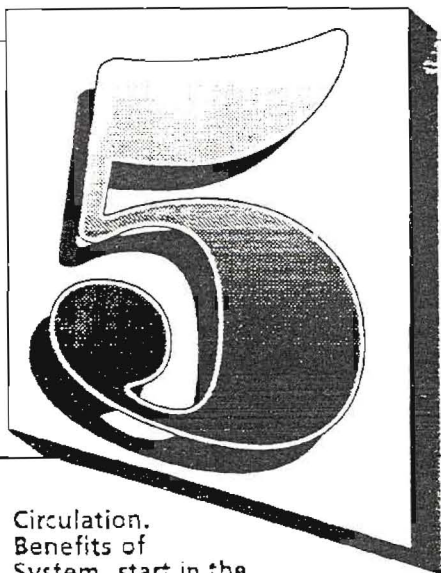
EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE
